
INSTITUTIONAL OVERVIEW

### **Institutional Overview**

Established in 1998, the Aurum Institute is an African Public Benefit Organisation whose mission is to improve the health of people and communities living in poverty through innovation **in global health** research, systems strengthening, and service delivery, specifically in the fields of HIV and TB.



The organisation's **legal structure** comprises several country offices (locally incorporated), and four affiliates. It also has office branches (not incorporated) in Namibia and eSwatini.



Operationally, the organisation has an **international unit** that manages multi-national projects, and units in **Ghana, Mozambique and South Africa** that focus on work in each country respectively. With an overall **staff complement of 3500 employees**, Aurum's work spans the cascade of healthcare from innovation to implementation, as illustrated below.

Aurum has a number of specialised areas within HIV, TB and Covid. A multidisciplinary team of scientists and subject matter specialists supports each project depending on the type of expertise needed.
